Dear Performers & Families,

Welcome to Playmakers Youth Theatre's production of *Disney's Newsies Jr!* Whether this is your millionth Playmakers show or your very first, we are so happy to have you here with us and can't wait to embark on this special experience together.

In this packet, you will find audition details, rehearsal & show information, an audition form to fill out, and a guide to The Playmakers Philosophy.

This production is open to 5th-9th graders. Auditions will be held at the Mandel JCC on Sunday, February 1st and do not require appointment or registration.

PLEASE NOTE: Auditions are now earlier in the day on Sunday to accommodate weather-related changes to our *Fiddler on the Roof* performance schedule. If your child would like to learn the song with our music director, they should arrive at 10:00 AM. If they will learn it on their own at home, they can arrive any time between 10:30 AM-12:30 PM.

For this audition, we have students sing songs from the show. This helps us with the casting process, but we do not ever want it to be stressful. We don't expect students to memorize or have perfected the songs, just to be familiar.

They will each have an opportunity to audition privately and can leave on a rolling basis as they finish their audition. We will try to see Cast A and A-B *Fiddler on the Roof*, Jr. performers first to maximize their time off before their February 1st performances.

The audition form, which can be found in this packet, can be printed ahead and brought to auditions to save time. We will also have hard copies available.

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We can't wait to bring this show — a beloved classic filled with dance, excellent storytelling, and excellent storytelling, and great opportunities for student performers — to life. As always, there are lots of surprises awaiting the cast and there will be so much for each performer to explore. Audition Process & Casting Information

Please complete the attached audition form and bring it with you on February 1st.

When the cast list is posted, you must email to accept or decline your role *and* register your child, including full payment of the participation fee.

Audition Song

Auditions will begin at 10:30 AM. Auditioners are invited at 10:00 AM to learn the audition songs from our music director, or to familiarize themselves with the music at home and arrive between 10:30 AM-12:30 PM. Then, we will see auditioners one at a time and they will be dismissed on a rolling basis as they finish. We will be teaching a cut of "Seize the Day" and a cut of "Carrying The Banner." No preparation is required, but the sheet music, tracks, and cuts of each are attached for students who would like to prepare in advance.

Participation Fees

There is no fee to audition. **Participation fees are \$325 for Mandel JCC members and \$375 for non-members. All participation fees must be paid in full prior to the first rehearsal and are due when you accept your child's role.**

Schedule

PLEASE NOTE: This production will have two different casts, each performing on their own weekend. Please be sure to list all conflicts (choir concerts, school commitments, other performances, after-school activities, family vacations, etc) on your audition form.

This is a very quick rehearsal process, which means it will be important for performers to prioritize rehearsal attendance. Please be sure to look carefully at the rehearsal schedule, tech dates, and performance calendar to make sure you are available. If you can only participate in one cast (because you have a conflict with the other cast's tech or performance dates), please be sure to note that on your form.



Rehearsals

Rehearsals will be held on Monday evenings (6:30-8:30 PM), Thursday evenings (6:30-8:30 PM), and Sunday afternoons (2:00-5:00 PM). Not all cast members will be called to all rehearsals. When we begin, you will receive a detailed schedule including call times for specific roles. All rehearsals are held at the Mandel JCC.

Tech Week

- Tech Week rehearsals are mandatory, with no late arrivals/early dismissals or absences permitted.

 - Wednesday, May 13th — 4:30 PM-9:00 PM

The 4 Ps of Playmakers: Pitch in & Promote the Playmakers Philosophy

Dear Families and Participants,

I grew up at Playmakers and Performing Arts Camp, as a performer, student, and camper, before becoming a counselor, assistant director, camp supervisor, and now, Playmakers Youth Theatre Director. That means that I know first hand the magic of this experience. I am also a professional director and producer, so I know that lots of feelings can come up during an audition process.

At Playmakers, performers of all experience-levels and ages bring a show to life alongside a supportive community. At Playmakers, children and teens build life-long friendships, find their voices, use their imaginations, challenge themselves, take risks, build confidence, work as a team, and explore their creativity. At Playmakers, we are proud of our performances but even prouder of our process, and know that, as our children and teens rehearse a show, learn choreography, and memorize lines, they are also building lasting memories and learning skills that help them grow.

As a director, I know how hard it is to audition and how stressful it can be to wait for the cast list to be posted. There is the desire to get a certain role, the complicated feeling of getting a part your friend might have wanted, and trying to understand why someone else was cast as a certain character.

Here's where the 4 P's come in. Unfortunately, we know we cannot shield kids and teens from disappointment, but we can be there for support and to help see the big picture. Two hundred sets of parents all have ideas of which one role would be perfect for their own child. I hope that we can all be prepared to promote the idea that a certain role isn't everything. We're here because we love the rehearsal process, working together as a team, and creating something wonderful that gives us each a sense of purpose and pride. Playmakers is a program built on understanding the importance of the process and building one another up, supporting one another, and having a blast along the way.

What I promise you is that we will approach this casting process fairly, honestly, and to the best of our ability. What I hope you and I can promise is that we will help our kids accept both excitement and disappointment gracefully and respectfully. We will support them, encourage them, and help them to make this show the fantastic experience we all know it will be, here at Playmakers where each of your children, no matter their role, truly shines.
